I was first licensed as KA1GBS in 1980. I was introduced to ham radio when my son Dale (now K1WU) was 13 years old and attended a summer school class in Morse code taught by a local ham. Dale and friends went on to get licensed in 1973. It took seven years for me to get up the courage to take the Novice exam but I've been hooked ever since. I upgraded to General in 1982 and Extra in 1984. I've been an active traffic handler in the ARRL's National Traffic System(NTS)since 1981, participating at all levels from local and section to region to area and Transcontinental Corps (TCC) on both CW and SSB. I operate a 24/7 scanning Pactor 1, 2 and 3 MBO on HF and a connecting VHF Packet station for NTSD. I am also involved in promoting the use of WL2K for message traffic and for coordinating with the Amateur Radio Emergency Service(ARES). My station consists of a Kenwood TS590SG, a G5RV multi-band antenna up around 45 to 50 feet, a tri-bander at 45 feet, a PTC He Pactor modem and a Kenwood TM281 and Kam plus modem for packet into a 13 element two meter beam up around 50 feet. I also have an Ameritron AL811H amplifier. I lived 14 years on Martha's Vineyard and was available for Dukes County contacts, but have since moved back to Concord. My most recent accomplishment was to re-activate a section CW traffic net (MARI) on 3565 Khz daily 7:00 PM ET. CW is still my favorite mode and I'm happy to see increasing interest in this
