President's Message

This month's scheduled guest speaker is Bob Peloquin, KB1VUA, who will be discussing Alternative Power Sources - a subject of considerable interest, even to non-hams (so bring your friends). As usual, the meeting will be held at the Framingham Police Headquarters Training Room on March 6th. No major winter storms are predicted.

The following Wednesday (12 March) there will be a license exam session at the shack. Registration begins at 7:15, exams begin at 7:30. Although the parking lot has been paved, access is still easier from Pearl St.

The Flea Market is fast approaching - Sunday, 6 April, from 9AM to noon at Keefe Tech. Volunteers are always welcome.

It's not too soon to be paying your dues. These may be paid at the meeting, or by mail (FARA, PO BOX 3005, Framingham, MA 01705-3005). Dues are still only \$15, \$10 for students and seniors over 65 years of age, with an additional \$10 for the repeater. Please include a registration form with your payment; it has been brought to my attention that we lack certain pieces of relevant information for many of our members. In addition to the obvious (Name, Address, Telephone #), there are some other items that are needed by the club: Callsign, License Class, ARRL Membership, VE Certification, Emcomm Training Level, Skywarn. Much of this data is available online, but it's easier for all concerned if you include it with your renewal.

As I've mentioned previously, the World Radiosport Team Championship (WRTC) will be held this year in Massachusetts from July 12-13; 59 2-operator teams will be set up with Field-Day-style stations on 16 properties around the Route 495 corridor. The WRTC2014 organizers need volunteers to help with this event; the biggest need is for people to help set up and keep an eye on the stations, and to provide local transportation for the teams between the headquarters hotel in Westborough and their various sites. The following weekend is the ARRL Centennial Convention, which will be held in Hartford. Registration (in advance) is \$25 - there's a non-radio companion ticket available, featuring alternate activities, as well. We're planning to have an informal dinner meeting on Friday night - any recommendations for restaurants located near the convention center would be welcome. Also, if you think you'd be interested, let us know, so an appropriately-sized reservation can be made (I doubt we'll be the only group with this notion - even if WE are The Food And Radio Association).
