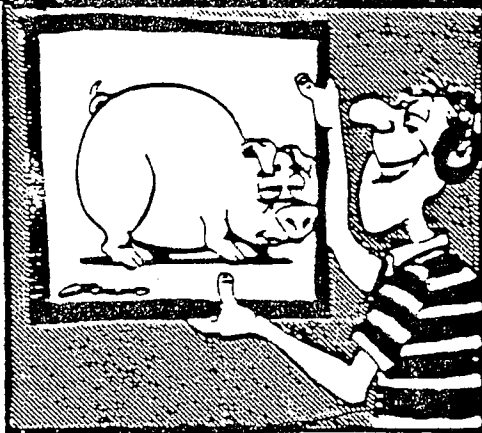

RON MENTIONED THE DISCUSSIONS TAKING PLACE BETWEEN THE ARRL AND THE F.C.C. REGARDING THE EXAMINER PROGRAM AND THERE WAS SOME QUESTION AS WETHER OR NOT THE ARRL WOULD BE ABLE TO RECOVER THE ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS OF ADMINISTERING THE EXAMS ON THE VOLUNTEER BASIS. (LEW KIAZE INDICATED THAT THE F.C.C. HAS AMENDED THE RULES TO ALLOW THE ARRL TO RECOVER THE COSTS.) WITH THIS IN MIND IT LOOKS LIKE WE ARE GOING TO BE IN A SITUATION WHERE THE VOLUNTEER EXAM PROGRAM WILL BE IN FULL SWING, VERY SHORTLY. A LETTER FROM THE ARRL TO ALL AFFILIATED CLUBS READS AS FOLLOWS: THE VOLUNTEER EXAMINER PROGRAMS NEEDS YOUR CLUB WITH THE NEW VOLUNTEER PROGRAM ON THE WAYTHERE IS NO REASON WHY ANY PERSON SHOULD HAVE TO TRAVEL FAR OR MISS EVEN ONE DAY OF WORK TO TAKE AN AMATEUR EXAM. ALTHOUGH WE HAVE HEARD FROM MANY PROSPECTIVE VOLUNTEER EXAMINERS WHO WISH TO INSURE THE AVAILABILITY OF THE EXAMS EVERYWHERE. WOULDN'T YOU LIKE TO PITCH IN AND HELP THE AMATEUR RADIO COMMUNITY, IT COULD MEAN NEW MEMBERS FOR YOUR CLUB. IF YOU WANT TO BECOME PART OF THIS EXCITING NEW PROGRAM. SEND IN THE NAME, CALL, CLASS OF LICENSE, ADDRESS AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF ADVANCED AND EXTRA CLASS OPERATORS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN BECOMING VOLUNTEER EXAMINERS TO ARRL HEADQUARTERS. "HOW TO REPAIR A TWO METER RIG" BY LEW NYMAN KIAZE

SOONER OR LATER, EVERY HAM IS PLAGUED WITH A TWO METER TRANSCEIVER THAT WON'T WORK. THE PROBLEM MAY BE A LOOSE CONNECTION, A DEFECTIVE PART, MISUSE, OR JUST PLAIN OLD AGE. IF YO POSSESS SOME BASIC TECHNICAL SKILLS YOU MAY WANT TO TRY THE FOLLOWING TECHNIQUES. THESE METHODS AREN'T GUARENTEED TO BRING RESULTS, BUT THEY WILL GIVE YOU SOMETHING TO DO BEFORE RESORTING TO SENDING THE RIG BACK TO THE FACTORY.

- STEP 1: APPROACH THE RADIO WITH A CONFIDENT MANNER. THIS WILL GIVE THE RADIO A MISTAKEN IMPRESSION THAT YOU KNOW SOMETHING. IT WILL ALSO IMPRESS ANYONE WHO MIGHT BE LOOKING, AND IF IT SHOULD SUDDENLY START WORKING YOU WILL BE CREDITED WITH THE REPAIR. IF THIS FAILS, PROCEED TO STEP 2.
- STEP 2: WAVE THE SERVICE MANUAL AT THE RADIO. THIS WILL MAKE IT ASSUME YOU UNDERSTAND ITS CIRCUITRY AND THAT YOU KNOW HOW TO READ A SCHEMATIC DIAGRAM. IF THIS FAILS, PROCEED TO STEP 3.
- STEP 3: IN A FORCEFUL MANNER RECITE OHM'S LAW. BEFORE YOU TAKE THIS STEP, BE SURE YOU KNOW IT. THIS WILL PROVE TO THE RADIO THAT YOU INDEED KNOW SOMETHING. IF THE RADIO STILL ISN'T IMPRESSED, PROCEED TO STEP 4.
- STEP 4: JAR THE RIG SLIGHTLY. THIS MAY REQUIRE ANYTHING FROM A 3 TO A 6 POUND HAMMER. HOWEVER, YOU MUST BE CAREFUL NOT TO DAMAGE THE HAMMER. IF THIS STEP STILL DOES NOT BRING RESULTS PROCEED TO THE NEXT STEP.
- STEP 5: WAVE A LARGE SCREWDRIVER IN A MENACING MANNER. THIS WILL SHOW THE RADIO THAT YOU KNOW THE DEADLY SHORT CIRCUIT TECHNIQUE.
- STEP 6: IF NOTHING ELSE WORKS, TRY TAKING SOME OHMMETER READINGS, ASSUMING YOU OWN AN OHMMETER. THIS SHOULD CONFUSE THE RADIO AND INCREASE YOUR ADVANTAGE.
- STEP 7: IF THE RADIO HAS NO SENTIMENTAL VALUE AND YOU'RE SICK AND TIRED OF FOOLING WITH IT, TRY BRINGING IT TO THE NEXT HAM RADIO FLEA MARKET IN YOUR AREA. PEOPLE WILL ALWAYS BUY JUNK AS WELL AS GOOD STUFF.
- STEP 8: IF YOU WANT TO MAKE A LAST DITCH EFFORT TO SAVE IT, AND YOU DO NOT WISH TO DISPLAY FURTHER IGNORANCE, BRING IT TO ANY ONE OF YOUR HAM RADIO BUDDIES SINCE THEY ARE MORE KNOWLEDGEABLE THAN YOU AND CLAIM TO BE EXPERTS. IF THIS STEP FAILS PROCEED TO STEP 9.
