LEW K1AZE READ A LETTER FROM THE ARRL REGARDING MALICIOUS INTERFERENCE. THE LETTER STATES; DEAR MEMBERS: THE PROBLEM OF MALICIOUS INTERFERENCE HAS REACHED SERIOUS PROPORTIONS INDEED IN THE MARCH QST EDITORIAL W1RU REFERED TO IT AS A CRISIS AND A CRISIS CANNOT BE IGNORED. THE ARRL BOARD OF DIRECTORS HAS RECENTLY ESTABLISHED AN INTERFERENCE TASK FORCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF INIT-IATING AN ON GOING PROGRAM OF ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL INTERFERENCE COMMITTEES. CLUBS OR INDIVIDUALS. THIS TASK FORCE SHALL: 1. COORDINATE AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM TO INCLUDE APPROPRIATE ARTICLES IN QST AND IN CLUB AND TRAINING PUBLICATIONS. 2. PROVIDE A REFERENCE MANUAL AND GUIDELINES FOR INTERFERENCE COMMITTEE OPERATING PROCEDURES. 3. PROVIDE LIASON AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL FOR THOSE CASES TO BE REFERED TO THE F.C.C. FOR THEIR HANDLING. IN THE MARCH 1980 QST EDITORIAL WE SOLICITED INPUT FROM THE MEMBERSHIP AND RECIEVED HUNDREDS OF LETTERS IN RESPONSE. ONE THING, WE LEARNED FROM THOSE LETTERS IS THAT SOME CLUBS OR GROUPS HAVE ALREADY ESTABLISHED LOCAL INTERFERENCE COMMITTEES TO HELP COMBAT MALICIOUS INTERFERENCE, SINCE, IT IS NOT OUR INTENTION TO REINVENT THE WHEEL BUT TO BUILD ON THE GOOD WORK THAT HAS GONE ON BEFORE. WE ARE WRITING ALL ARRL AFFILIATED CLUBS TO LEARN WHATEVER IN-FORMATION WE CAN ON INTERFERENCE COMMITTEES THAT ALREADY EXIST. WE ASK THAT YOU ANSWER THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS. 1. DOES YOUR CLUB HAVE AN ORGANIZED PRO--CEEDURE TO DEAL WITH INTERFERENCE CASES THAT COME TO YOUR ATTENTION. 2. DO YOU HAVE ANY FORMAL GUIDE LINES OR PROCEEDURES SUCH AS A PROCEDUAL MANUAL FOR THE ABOVE AND MAY WE HAVE A COPY. 3. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE AN ORGANIZED SYSTEM FOR HANDLING INTERFERENCE CASES WOULD YOU BE INTERESTED IN ESTABLISH-ING ONE, GIVEN PROCEDUAL GUIDANCE FROM THE INTERFERENCE TASK FORCE. WE INTEND TO BUILD A DATA FILE OF PRESENT AND FUTURE LOCAL INTERFERENCE COMMITTEES TO FACILITATE THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION . THE MEMBERSHIP OF THESE COMMITTEES WILL BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL...SIGNED HAL STYNMAN K1FHN.....
