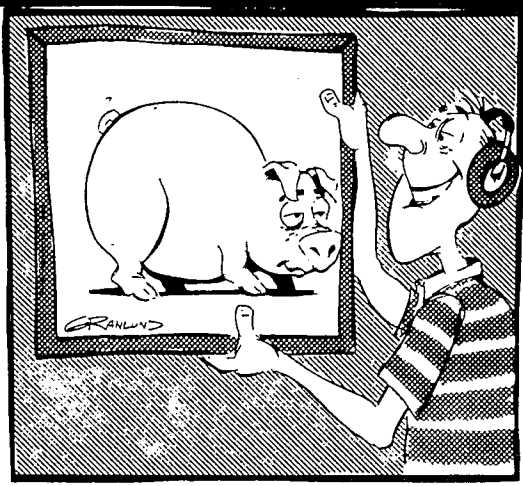

ITEMS COVERED WERE PREAMBLE, ADDRESSEE, TEXT COUNT, SIGNATURE, HANDLING INSTRUCTION AND "ARRL" CODED ABBREVIATION. ALL OF WHICH CAN BE FOUND IN THE REAR OF ALL "ARRL LOG BOOKS. WHAT SAY HW ABT GET'G HAM RADIO MORE ACTIVE IN PUBLIC SERVICE? USE THOSE RIGS THAT HAVE NOT BEEN FIRED UP. LETS HAVE SOME FUN AT PARADES, SPORTS EVENTS. LETS FEEL GUD WE HELPED SOMEONE, SUCH AS THE MEDICAL TRAFFIC MENTIONED EARLIER, COORDINATE AN EFFORT LOOKING FOR A LOST PERSON, COMMUNICATORS FOR OUT OF TOWN HELP SENT TO AID IN A SITUATION, ETC.

MANY OF US BY OUR NATURE WANT TO BE PART OF THE ACTION OR AT LEAST WANT TO ASSIST IN A SITUATION. WHY BE FRUSTRATED BECAUSE NO ONE CALLED YOU? YOU HAD THE RIG HOT AND READY, RIGHT? FCC EXAM SUGGESTIONS OR QUESTIONS SHOULD NO LONGER GO TO BOB KITE, CITED IN A RECENT ASSOCIATION BULLETIN BUT WHO MOVED ON SOME MONTHS AGO. JAY JACKSON OF THE PERSONAL RADIO DIVISION, (202) 634-6619, IS NOW THE EXAM CONTACT. (HRR)

LOW DOWN QRP

THER WILL ALWAYS BE SOME HAMS LOOKING FOR NEW FRONTIERS AWAY FROM THE CROWDED BANDS. THEY LOOK TO EXOTIC MODES OF HIGHER AND HIGHER FREQUENCIES. THEY BOUNCE THEIR SIGNALS OFF METEORS OR LISTEN TO THE STARS. IF YOU DO THIS KIND OF THING YOU ARE AN EXPERIMENTER AT HEART. WITHOUT PEOPLE LIKE YOU THERE WOULD BE NO AMATEUR RADIO AS WE KNOWN IT TODAY, THE EXPERIMENTER IS FACED WITH HIGH COSTS ALSO. FORTUNATELY, THERE IS AN ALTERNATIVE, WHICH WILL COST YOU VERY LITTLE, BUT CAN STILL GIVE YOU THE THRILL OF EXPLORING LITTLE KNOWN FREQUENCIES. EVER HEAR OF THE 1750 METER BAND?

ALTHOUGH MANY PEOPLE DON'T KNOW IT, THERE IS ONE COUNTRY IN THE WORLD WHICH ALLOWS UNLICENSED COMMUNICATIONS ON SEVERAL FREQUENCIES, THAT COUNTRY IS THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. HOWEVER, PART 15 OF THE FCC REGULATIONS IMPOSES POWER AND OTHER RESTRICTIONS. THE BEST DEAL IS IN THE 1750 METER BAND WHERE THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY:

OPERATION BETWEEN 160 AND 190 KHZ IS PERMITTED IF THE POWER INPUT TO THE FINAL STAGE OF THE TRANSMITTER (EXCLUSIVE OF FILAMENT) IS NOT GREATER THAN ONE WATT, ALL EMISSIONS OUTSIDE OF THE BAND ARE SUPPRESSED AT LEAST 20 DB BELOW THE UNMODULATED CARRIER, AND THE ANTENNA LENGTH DOES NOT EXCEED 50 FEET (EXCLUDING LOADING COILS AND GROUND RADIALS). IN PLAIN TERMS, THAT MEANS UNRESTRICTED SHORT RANGE COMMUNICATIONS BY ANY MODE AND YOU USE ANY CALL LETTERS YOU WANT (BUT YOU MUST NOT USE YOUR AMATEUR CALLSIGN).

IF YOU DON'T HAVE YOUR NOVICE LICENSE YET YOU CAN USE THE BAND FOR CODE PRACTICE -- UNLESS IT BECOMES A HAM BAND AT WARC - 79. HERE IN NEW ENGLAND THE BAND IS MOST ACTIVE DURING THE WINTER MONTHS ON SATURDAY MORNINGS. DISTANCES OF 100 MILES OR MORE ARE POSSIBLE. IT IS VERY EASY TO BUILD A TRANSMITTER FOR USE AT SUCH LOW FREQUENCIES (SEE KEN CORNELL'S BOOK) AND RECIEVERS OR CONVERTERS ARE READILY AVAILABLE. YOUR HOME-BREW TRANSMITTER SHOUD BEAR THE FOLLOWING DECLARATION: I HAVE CONSTRUCTED THIS DEVICE FOR MY OWN USE. I HAVE TESTED IT AND CERTIFY THAT IT COMPLIES WITH THE APPLICABLE REGULATIONS OF FCC RULES PART 15. ~~A COPY OF MY MEASUREMENTS IS IN MY POSSESSION AND IS AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION. (ADD YOUR SIGNATURE AND DATE).~~

PROPAGATION CONDITIONS VARY LITTLE AT LOW FREQUENCIES AND THE BACK-GROUND NOISE IS LEAST DURING THE WINTER. DIMMERS MAY CAUSE UNPLEASANT NOISES. THEREFOR THE ADDITION OF A CW FILTER IS VERY USEFUL WHEN COPYING CODE. YOU WILL ALSO HEAR SOME UNMODULATED CARRIRS ON THE BAND GENERATED BY THE POWER COMPANY OPERATIONS (SEE QST, MARCH 1978, P. 36). HOWEVER, THERE IS STILL PLENTY OF ROOM FOR NEW LOW-FERS (LOW FREQUENCY EXPERIMENTAL RADIO STATIONS). SO DIG INTO THE SPARES BOX FOR AN OLD PENTODE AND RELIVE THE EARLY DAYS OF HAM RADIO. BUT PLEASE TAKE CARE OF AN INCREASED SHOCK HAZARD WHICH IS ASSOCIATED WITH LOW FREQUENCY TRANSMITTERS.

I HOPE TO HEAR YOU ON THE BAND THIS WINTER, AND IF YOU SHOULD HEAR ME SIGNING "ADX", PLEASE GIVE ME A CALL OR MAIL A RECEPTION REPORT.
