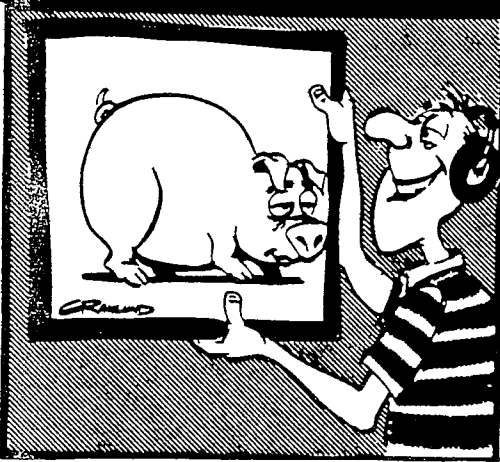

TO DR. HAROLD S. KOST K1HK OF HOLLISTON HAS BEEN ELECTED VICE PRESIDENT AND MEDICAL DIRECTOR BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF JOHN HANCOCK MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE CO., IT WAS ANNOUNCED BY JOHN G. McELWEE, CHAIRMAN AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER. THE ELECTION IS EFFECTIVE JAN.10, 1983.

DR. KOST JOINED THE HANCOCK IN 1967 AS ASSISTANT MEDICAL DIRECTOR AND WAS LATER PROMOTED TO ASSOCIATE MEDICAL DIRECTOR, SENIOR ASSOCIATE MEDICAL DIRECTOR AND GENERAL MEDICAL DIRECTOR. HE WAS ELECTED SECOND VICE PRESIDENT, MEDICAL DEPARTMENT, IN 1981.

DR. KOST WAS GRADUATED FROM PREMEDICAL AND MEDICAL SCHOOL AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS. HE IS PRESIDENT OF THE ASSOCIATION OF INSURANCE MEDICAL DIRECTORS OF AMERICA, A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL OF LIFE INSURANCE AND A DIPLOMATE OF THE AMERICAN BOARD OF LIFE INSURANCE MEDICINE. HE IS ALSO A FELLOW OF THE LIFE MANAGEMENT INSTITUTE.

A CLINICAL INSTRUCTOR IN MEDICINE OF THE AMERICAN BOARD OF INTERNAL MEDICINE, DR. KOST IS A DIPLOMATE OF THE AMERICAN BOARD OF INTERNAL MEDICINE AND A MEMBER OF THE AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION, THE AMERICAN OCCUPATIONAL MEDICAL ASSOCIATION, THE MASSACHUSETTS MEDICAL SOCIETY AND THE SUFFOLK DISTRICT MEDICAL SOCIETY.

HE IS ALSO VICE PRESIDENT OF THE AMERICAN LUNG ASSOCIATION OF MASSACHUSETTS AND CHAIRMAN OF ITS ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY GUIDANCE COMMITTEE, A MEMBER OF THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION AND A MEMBER OF THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE STATEWIDE CHILDHOOD INJURY PREVENTION PROGRAM.

YOU ARE INVITED TO LISTEN AND TALK TO VIC CLARK, W4KFC, PRESIDENT OF THE ARRL, WHEN HE DISCUSSES "THE FUTURE OF AMATEUR RADIO" ON THE TELECONFERENCE RADIO NET, THURSDAY, MARCH 3, 1983 AT 8:15 EST. THIS IS YOUR CHANCE TO HEAR ABOUT THE FUTURE OF AMATEUR RADIO DIRECT FROM THE PERSON WHO HAS AND WILL PLAY A LARGE PART IN MAKING THAT FUTURE!

IN THE BOSTON AREA YOU MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE CONFERENCE THROUGH THE HONEYWELL 1200 RC SPONSORED BILLERICA REPEATER 147.72/12 MHZ. ALL AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS ARE WELCOME TO PARTICIPATE AND NON HAMS MAY LISTEN ON VHF SCANNER TYPE RADIOS OR CONTACT AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS NEAR THEM. ALL AMATEURS ARE WELCOME TO CHECK INTO THE NET, HOWEVER IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO CHECK INTO THE NET TO PARTICIPATE.

DURING THE TELECONFERENCE 18 AMATEUR REPEATERS AROUND THE USA WILL BE CONNECTED TO ALLOW TWO WAY CONFERENCING. THE TELECONFERENCE RADIO NET USES THE LATEST MULTIPOINT TELECONFERENCE TECHNOLOGY TO TIE TOGETHER REPEATERS ACROSS THE U.S. THE OBJECTIVE IS TO ALLOW HAMS TO LISTEN AND TALK TO LEADERS AND EXPERTS FROM AMATEUR RADIO, SCIENTIFIC AND ELECTRONIC COMMUNITIES. TYPICALLY, MORE THAN 2,000 AMATEURS ARE TUNED INTO THE SPEAKER FOR QUESTIONS AND DISCUSSION.
